The programme was clearly a hit amongst the guests, and the Denis team will be gearing up to put even more special touches to the 2016-2017 festive holiday programme.

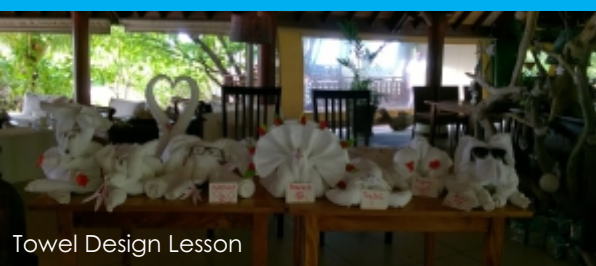
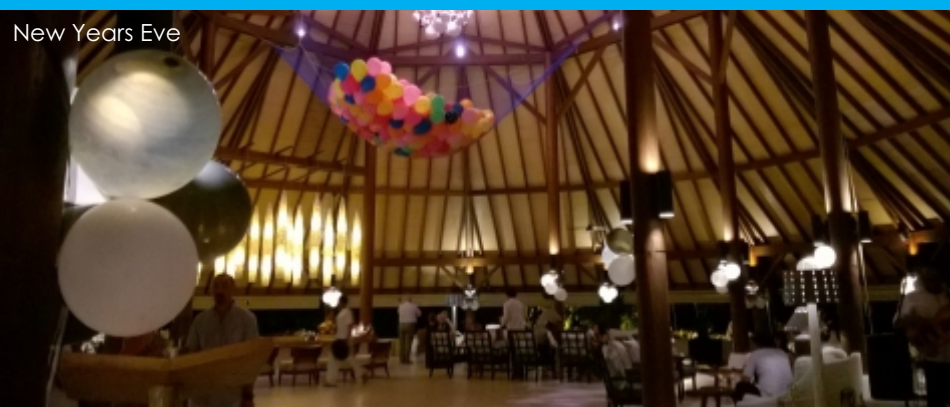
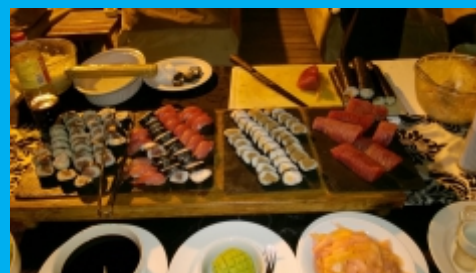
