Denis Private Island invites visitors to experience the charms of a natural paradise – one in which the island shapes every aspect of the hotel, its cuisine, décor and conservation programmes. With only 23 freestanding cottages and villas, the island is a living, breathing community, with guests able to explore some of the world's most breath-taking beaches and coral reefs, in equal measure with the island's farm, mill, staff village and other interesting features of this tropical hideaway.



Every inch of the island's 375 acres, as well as its surrounding reefs, allow limitless exploration. Island tours are free of charge and organised daily by the Green Islands Foundation, which runs a variety of conservation programmes on the island. The island's pathways offer glimpses of some of the rarest birds on earth, giant tortoises and sea turtles which can be seen from shore in the shallows of the lagoon.

# Fishing & Cruising

Denis is renowned for its abundance and diversity of big game, and ranks as one of the top sailfish destinations in the world year after year. In addition to trolling for marlin, sailfish, dorado, tuna and wahoo, fishermen can also try their hand at bottom-fishing for snapper and grouper, with a traditional hand-line. Fly-fishing is also possible, provided guests bring their own equipment. All fishing is carried out in accordance with the island's conservation guidelines, and the boat house strictly adheres to International Game Fishing Association's tag-and-release programme. Half-day charters are available on request.














- A completely private coral islet of 375 acres, exclusively reserved for guests to share with nature
